Introduction

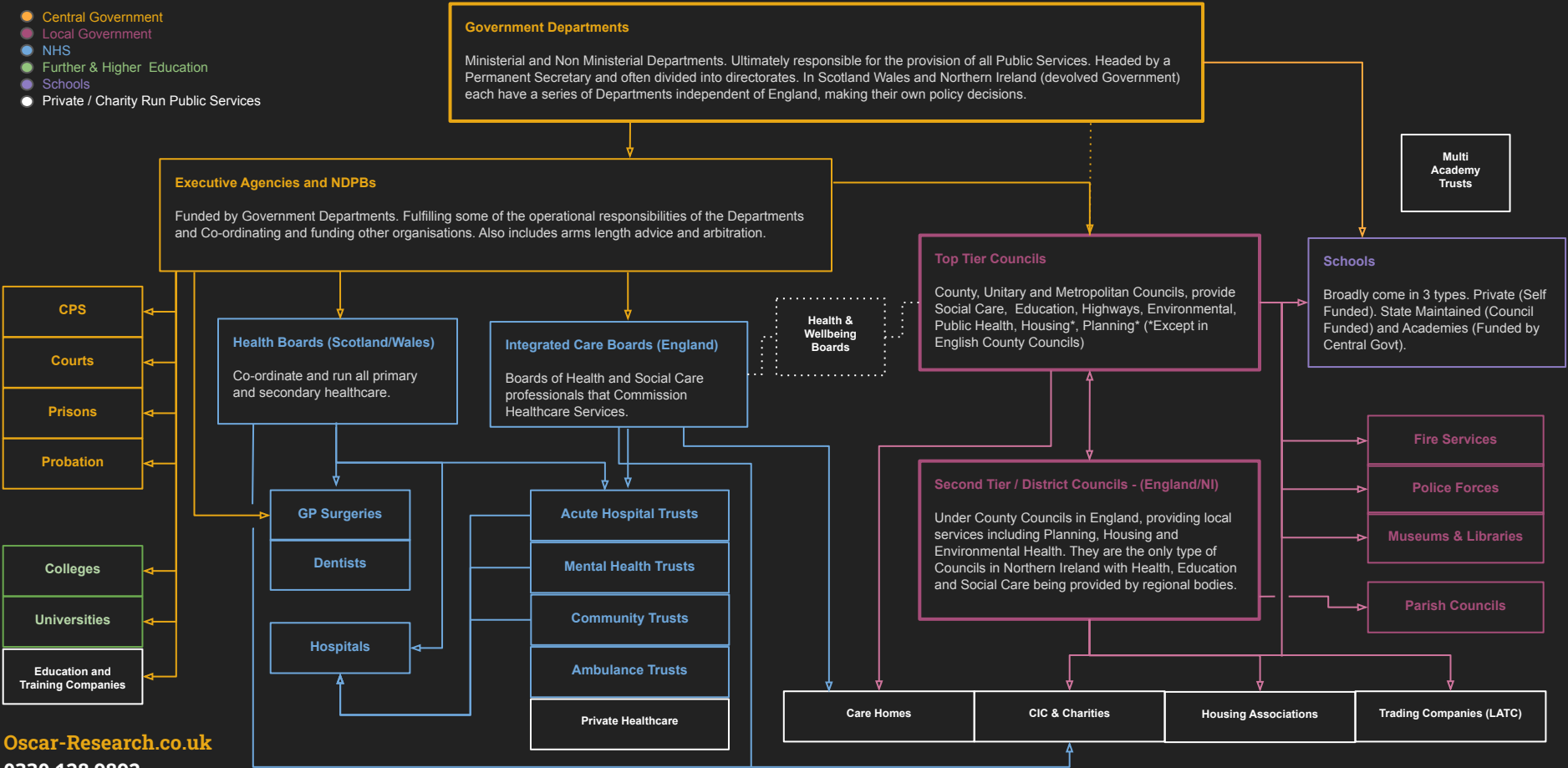
Founded in 1999, Oscar Research provides data, intelligence and digital solutions for those wishing to understand & communicate with UK Public Services.

Part of our work involves the understanding of the structure, funding and make-up of the Public Sector and the delivery of it's services. The following high level chart shows, in the simplest possible form, the flow of funding and service delivery through the Government and Public Services.

Broadly speaking, funding comes in two forms: National Level taxation levied against both individuals and business which is then spent through Central Government Departments and their devolved equivalents and Local taxation in the form of Council and Business Tax which is paid by residents in the respective Council administrative areas (paid at a District level in two tier council areas). Individual organisations also raise funds through a variety of other means, including Parking, Rents, Advertising and Training.

We have attempted to also reflect the increasing trend towards private and third sector provision of Public Services. These can be anything from a Charitable Home Care agency delivering services on behalf of a Council, a Private Hospital being Commissioned via an ICB to provide Healthcare services, a private Training company offering publicly funded courses, Housing Associations providing Social Housing services and many others.
